AUC CONTRIBUTION TO THE VICTORY IN THE WAR

- organises and coordinates humanitarian aid in cooperation with the Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine and military administrations
- coordinates urgent restoration work in communities in cooperation with public authorities and international partners
- provides explanations and assistance to communities in developing and making decisions on the life-support of villages, settlements and cities
- develops and lobbies for the necessary legislative changes for the effective operation and provision of services by municipalities in wartime
- participates in the National Council for the Reconstruction of Ukraine from the aftermath of the war under the President of Ukraine, approved by the Decree of the President of Ukraine of 21 April, 2022 № 266/2022
- engages international organisations and partner associations around the world in supporting Ukrainian communities, promotes inter-municipal assistance
- communicates the signing of partnership agreements with foreign municipalities
- acted as a co-initiator and partner of the online platform Cities4Cities, which helps Ukrainian communities find assistance from European municipalities
- organises and coordinates mutual support and assistance of AUC members - food and other necessary items are sent to frontline and occupied communities by rear communities

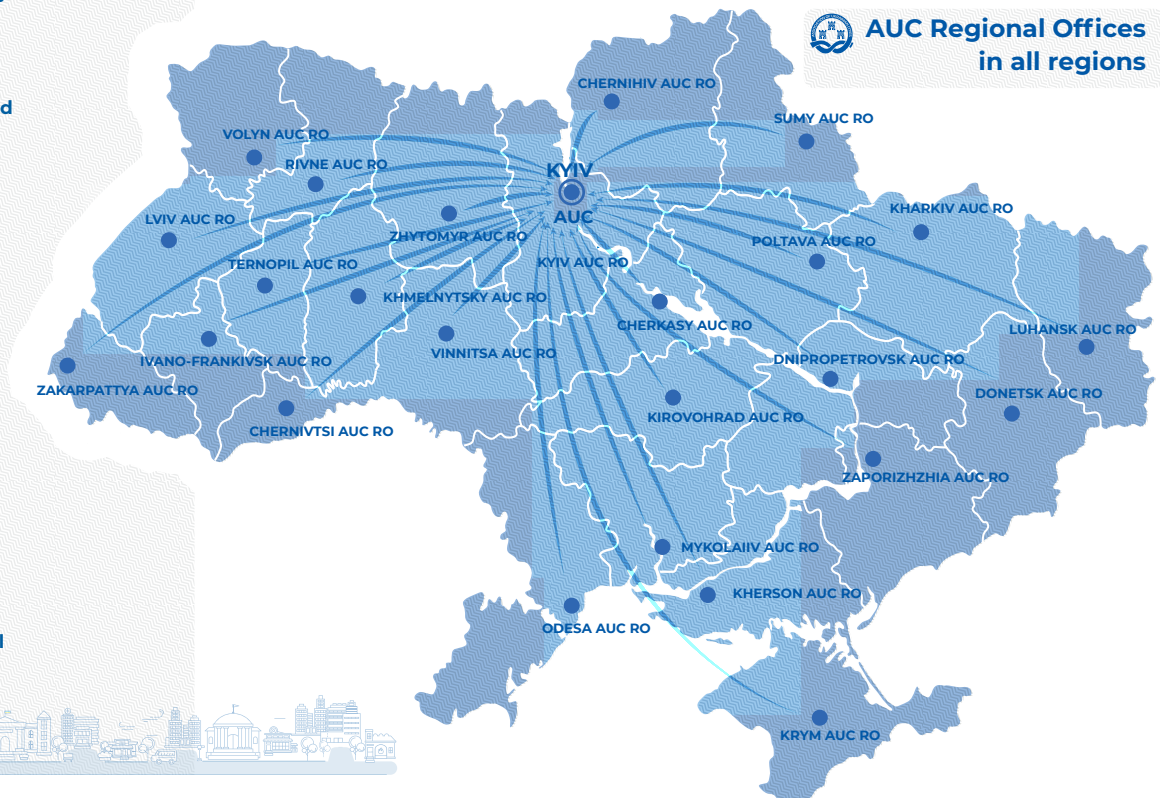

The AUC takes every effort to release the mayors captured by the Russian military, constantly working with the international community. During the war, the occupiers have abducted 55 local officials, 35 of whom were mayors. 32 mayors and 18 local representatives have been released. As of October, 2024, three mayors and one community starosta (head) remain in captivity

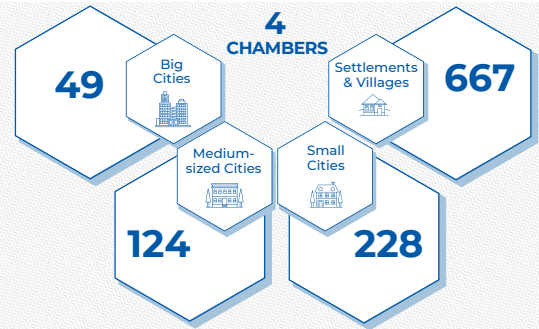
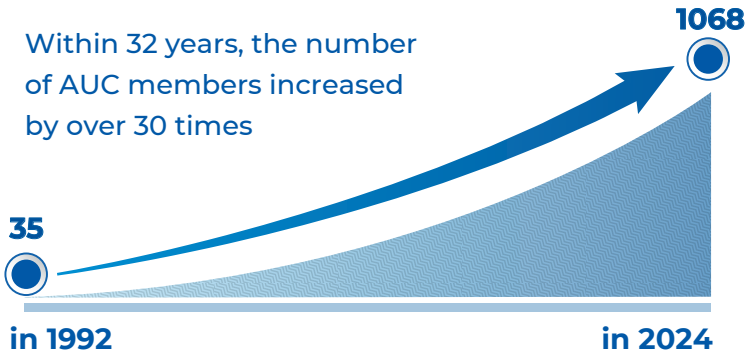




ASSOCIATION OF UKRAINIAN CITIES
